**A. CALL TO ORDER**

**D. REGULAR AGENDA ITEMS**

- 1. Hold a public hearing on a proposal to consider a tax rate, which will exceed the lower of the rollback rate or the effective tax rate and will increase total tax revenues from properties on the tax roll in the preceding tax year by 11.55%.**

Mayor Pro Tem Harrison announced that this is the second of two public hearings to discuss the Fiscal Year 2019-2020 proposed tax rate of \$.647489 that represents the same tax rate as the Fiscal Year 2018-2019 tax rate of \$.647489. The City Council will vote on both the Fiscal Year 2019-2020 Proposed Budget and the proposed tax rate at a meeting scheduled on September 18, 2019 at 6:30 p.m. located at Krum City Hall at 146 W. McCart, Krum, Texas. Once the public hearing is opened, the public is encouraged to express their views.

Mayor Pro Tem Rhonda Harrison opened the agenda item. There were no questions or discussion.


**E. EXECUTIVE SESSION – None**
